

Hyper Fox Privacy Policy

Effective Date: July 30, 2025

This Privacy Policy explains how **Hyper Fox** (“we” or “us”), which includes our Discord bot and the website **hyperfox.world**, collects, uses, shares, and protects your personal information. We are committed to safeguarding user privacy and adhere to applicable privacy laws in the United States (including California, New York, and other state laws), the European Union (GDPR), and the United Kingdom. By using Hyper Fox, you agree to the data practices described in this policy.

Information We Collect

We **minimize** the personal data we collect. The only information we collect from you includes:

- **Hashed Discord User ID:** When you use our Discord bot and visit our website through the bot’s link, we identify your account by a hashed version of your Discord ID. This hashed ID is a unique anonymized identifier that **does not reveal your actual Discord username or ID**. We use a one-way hashing algorithm (with secret salts) so that the ID cannot be easily reversed to the original ID, ensuring your privacy is protected ¹. We do **not** collect any other Discord account information (no usernames, emails, or avatars).
- **Hashed IP Address:** For security and anti-fraud purposes, we log your IP address in **hashed** form. This means we store an encrypted fingerprint of your IP rather than the IP itself. Logging a hashed IP helps us detect abuse (for example, preventing one person from creating multiple fake accounts or exploiting our offers) while maintaining your privacy ¹. *We do not currently use the hashed IP in production, but we plan to implement this soon as an extra fraud prevention measure.* As with the user ID, the hashing is one-way – we cannot retrieve your actual IP from the stored hash.
- **No Other Personal Data: We do not collect any other personal information.** We do **not** ask for your name, email address, physical address, phone number, or any demographic details. **Importantly, we do not use cookies or any similar tracking technologies on our website** ². Our site does not plant any cookies on your device and does not track your activity across other sites. We also do not use analytics services that would collect additional data about you. In short, aside from the hashed identifiers mentioned above, **nothing else about you or your device is collected by Hyper Fox.**

How We Use Your Information

We strictly use the limited data we collect to operate and improve the Hyper Fox service. Specifically:

- **Providing the Service:** Your hashed Discord ID is used to recognize you within Hyper Fox’s system. This allows us to link your Discord account to in-bot games and the offer wall on our website. For

example, when you complete a survey or offer, we use the hashed ID to credit your Hyper Fox account with the appropriate points or rewards.

- **Offer Wall Integration:** We pass your hashed Discord ID to our third-party offer/survey providers (TheoremReach and AdGem) through an embedded web frame. This unique identifier lets those providers know which user (in a pseudonymous way) is completing an offer, so they can inform us to reward you appropriately. Using a hashed ID means that even though we identify you for reward purposes, **your actual identity is not shared** with the offer providers.
- **Fraud Detection and Security:** We use the hashed IP address to help detect and prevent fraudulent or abusive behavior. For instance, if we notice numerous accounts originating from the same hashed IP, we may investigate for potential abuse. This measure protects the integrity of our rewards system and helps ensure a fair experience for all users. By hashing the IP, we can flag suspicious activity without storing your actual IP address in plain text (adding a layer of privacy protection).
- **Internal Analytics (No Personal Tracking):** We may perform basic counting of usage (e.g. how many users use our survey feature) using only anonymous, aggregate data. We do **not** profile individual users or track your behavior beyond what is necessary to run our games and services. Any usage metrics we collect are devoid of personal identifiers. We **do not** use your information for advertising or marketing purposes, nor for any kind of personal profiling.
- **Communication:** If you reach out to us (for example, via our support email), we will use any contact information you provide (such as your email address) only to respond to your inquiry or request. Since our bot and website themselves do not collect emails or messaging info, the only time we'd have your contact info is if you initiate contact with us.

We do **not** use your data for any purpose not described in this policy. In particular, we do not sell, rent, or monetize your personal data in any way ³, and we do not use it for automated decisions that produce legal or similarly significant effects on you.

How We Share Your Information

We know your privacy is important, so we only share your data in a very limited way, as described below:

- **Offer and Survey Providers:** As noted, we share **only your hashed Discord ID** with our third-party partners that provide the offer wall and surveys within Hyper Fox. These partners currently include **TheoremReach** (surveys) and **AdGem** (offer wall). The hashed ID is provided so that when you complete an offer or survey, they can inform us of the completion tied to your account. **We do not share your Discord username, real name, IP address, or any other personal information with these providers – only the anonymized ID.** This ID by itself does not identify you to the providers; it simply acts as a user number for our system.
- **Service Providers:** We may share information with service providers who support our operations (for example, our web hosting/datacenter or database provider, or analytics tools that operate on anonymized data). In all cases, these providers are bound by contracts to only use the data on our behalf and not disclose it further. They help us run Hyper Fox (e.g. hosting the website and database

in New York, USA) and are not permitted to use your data for their own purposes. We ensure any such service providers commit to appropriate privacy and security standards.

- **Legal Requirements:** We may disclose your information if we are legally compelled to do so (for instance, in response to a valid court order, subpoena, or law enforcement request), or if we believe in good faith that such disclosure is necessary to comply with applicable laws. We may also share information if needed to detect or prevent fraud, security issues, or other technical problems, or to protect the rights, property, or safety of Hyper Fox, our users, or the public. If we ever receive a government or legal request for user data, our policy is to review it carefully and only comply if required by law.
- **Business Transfers:** In the unlikely event that Hyper Fox undergoes a business transaction such as a merger, acquisition, or sale of assets, user information (which in our case is minimal) may be transferred to the new owner/partner as part of that deal. If such a transfer occurs, we will ensure the successor honors the commitments we have made in this Privacy Policy regarding your data.

Importantly, we do NOT sell your personal information to anyone ³. “Selling” in this context means sharing it for monetary gain or for others’ independent use, which we do not do. The only sharing we do is the necessary sharing outlined above (e.g. with our service partners to run the offer system, or as required by law). We also do not share data for targeted advertising or marketing purposes. In other words, your hashed IDs and IPs are used strictly within the confines of the Hyper Fox service and its requisite features.

Third-Party Offer Providers (TheoremReach and AdGem)

Hyper Fox works with third-party companies to provide **rewarded surveys and offer walls** that you can complete to earn points. The two main partners are **TheoremReach** (for surveys) and **AdGem** (for various offers like apps, videos, etc.). While using these features, it’s important to understand how your data might be handled by these third parties:

- **Data Shared with Providers:** As noted, we only transmit a hashed identifier (your Discord ID in hashed form) to TheoremReach and AdGem. This allows them to associate survey completions or offer completions with your Hyper Fox account for reward purposes. We do not send them your actual Discord ID, name, or any other personal details. Because the ID is hashed, it’s a pseudonymous tag that **by itself does not reveal your Discord identity** to the provider.
- **Data Collected by Providers:** When you engage with a survey or offer, **you are interacting with TheoremReach or AdGem directly through an embedded frame** on our site. These providers may collect additional information from you or your device during that interaction. For example, they might use their own cookies, gather device identifiers, IP address, or other usage information, and of course, any answers you provide in a survey are collected by them. They may also have anti-fraud measures (device fingerprinting, etc.) and **could link your participation to other data they have about you**. This data collection is governed by **their** privacy policies, not ours. We want to be transparent that **TheoremReach and AdGem have their own terms regarding data use**, which can be more extensive than our minimal data collection.

- **Third-Party Privacy Practices:** Both TheoremReach and AdGem **may use or share the information they collect for various purposes**, such as improving their services, preventing fraud, or even monetizing data (for instance, targeted advertising or research). In fact, AdGem's privacy policy indicates it may share personal information with affiliates and service providers for purposes like marketing and analytics ⁴. Some offer providers in this industry **do sell or license data about user responses and behaviors** as part of their business models. **Hyper Fox does not endorse or control how these third parties use your data**, but we want you to be aware of it. **We strongly encourage you to review the privacy policies of TheoremReach and AdGem** (available on their websites) before participating in offers or surveys, so you understand what data they might collect and how they might use it.
- **Limiting Data Exposure:** By using hashed IDs, Hyper Fox limits the personal data we directly share with these providers. They see an alphanumeric user ID and nothing that immediately identifies you as a Discord user or reveals your real identity. This is one way we protect your privacy. Nonetheless, any information you voluntarily provide to an offer (e.g., filling out a survey with demographic info) will naturally be obtained by that provider. If you have concerns about a particular survey question or offer, you have the choice not to participate.

In summary, **while Hyper Fox itself collects very little information about you, the third-party offer walls you access through our service operate under their own privacy and data collection rules**. We only share what is absolutely necessary (the hashed ID) and we do not provide them with your personal info. But for any additional data those services collect directly, please refer to TheoremReach's and AdGem's privacy documentation. We want you to feel informed and in control when using these features.

Cookies and Tracking Technologies

For clarity, we reiterate that **Hyper Fox does not use any cookies, trackers, or profiling scripts** on our website. When you visit hyperfox.world (for example, to access the survey/offer iframe), we do not place cookies on your browser, and we do not use web beacons, local storage, or any similar tracking technology. There are **no** Google Analytics, advertising pixels, or social media plugins on our site. This means we are **not tracking your browsing behavior** in the way many websites do with cookies. Your interaction with our site is essentially limited to the functional content (the game-related frames) and nothing more. This approach ensures that, aside from the necessary communication with our offer providers, your web browsing remains private and untracked by Hyper Fox ².

(Note: TheoremReach and AdGem's embedded content may use cookies or tracking on their side within the iframe. Those would be subject to their policies, and outside of Hyper Fox's direct control. Hyper Fox itself, however, sets no cookies and performs no cross-site tracking.)

Data Retention

We retain the minimal data we collect for only as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes described in this policy:

- **Hashed Discord IDs:** We keep your hashed user ID in our database as long as you are an active user of Hyper Fox. This allows us to keep crediting your account with points and processing your

redemptions. If you stop using Hyper Fox, we may continue to retain the hashed ID (and associated reward history) for a period of time in case you return, and to maintain the integrity of our rewards system and prevent duplicate accounts. However, if you request deletion of your data (see **Your Rights** below), we will remove your hashed ID from our records.

- **Hashed IP Addresses:** Once implemented, hashed IP logs will be retained for a limited time necessary for fraud detection. We anticipate only keeping a rolling record (for example, hashed IPs associated with actions might be kept for a few months). We will not retain hashed IP data longer than needed to identify and mitigate abuse patterns. Regular purging will ensure we aren't keeping even pseudonymous IP information indefinitely. If the hashed IP becomes irrelevant (e.g., no fraud detected related to it), it will be deleted or overwritten in due course.
- **Survey/Offer Completion Data:** When you complete offers or surveys, we record the event (for instance, that a certain hashed user earned points from a specific offer at a given time). These records are kept to track your point balance, enable reward redemption, and for auditing our system (preventing fraud or errors in crediting). We keep these transactional logs for as long as you have an account, and for a reasonable time after, in case of disputes or audits. Aggregated (non-personal) statistics about offers (like total offers completed) may be retained indefinitely, but those contain no personal identifiers.
- **Communication Records:** If you contact us via email or support, we may retain that correspondence (including your email address and any other info you provide) for as long as needed to address your issue and as required by law or our internal backup policies. If you request deletion of such communications, and if we are not legally required to keep them, we will delete those as well.

When data is deleted from our active systems, we will also ensure it is removed from any backups or archives within a reasonable timeframe (though note that backups may not be immediate to update, but we will not restore deleted data back into active systems). All deletions are permanent and irrecoverable – once your hashed ID or other info is removed, it cannot be retrieved.

Your Rights and Choices

We respect your rights over your personal data. Because we operate internationally, different laws may grant you specific rights. Regardless of your location, **we provide all users with the ability to inquire about, access, or delete their data.** Key rights include:

- **Right to Access:** You have the right to ask us for a copy of the personal data we hold about you (which, in our case, would typically just be your hashed Discord ID and any related reward records). We will provide you with a summary of that information in a readable format, explaining what we have and how it's used.
- **Right to Deletion:** You have the right to request that we delete the personal information we have collected from you. As noted, this primarily means you can ask us to remove your hashed Discord ID from our systems (which would effectively terminate your Hyper Fox account and erase your points and reward history), and to delete any associated records like offer completions tied to your ID. We

honor deletion requests unless we have a specific legal obligation to retain data (for example, for fraud investigations or a legal dispute). Once your data is deleted, you will not be able to recover any points or account history, so please consider that when making a deletion request.

- **Right to Correction:** If you believe the information we have (limited as it is) is incorrect or incomplete, you have the right to request we correct it. This might be seldom needed given we only store hashed IDs and numeric values (points), but if, for instance, you think there's an error in your points balance due to a data issue, you can contact us to investigate and rectify it.
- **Right to Know (California Residents):** If you are a California resident, you have the right to request that we disclose certain information to you about our collection and use of your personal information over the past 12 months, such as the categories of personal information collected, the purposes, and any third parties with whom we shared it. This Privacy Policy is intended to provide much of that information openly (we collect identifiers like a hashed ID and IP, use them for service and fraud prevention, and share only as described). But you can also contact us for further details or confirmation of these points, and we will respond as required by the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA) and the California Privacy Rights Act (CPRA).
- **Right to Opt-Out of Sale/Sharing:** We do not sell your data, so there is no sale to opt out of ³. If you are in a jurisdiction with "Do Not Sell or Share" rights (like California), rest assured we already do not sell or share personal info for cross-context advertising. If that ever changes (unlikely for our service), we will update this policy and provide a mechanism for you to opt out. As of now, there's no need for an opt-out because we simply don't engage in those practices.
- **Right to Non-Discrimination:** We will never punish or treat you differently for exercising any of your privacy rights. If you ask to delete your data, we won't deny you the use of our service except insofar as we cannot provide the service without that data (for example, if you delete your hashed ID, you can't earn or redeem points because we no longer have a record of you – but that's a natural consequence, not a punitive action). We do not offer financial incentives for your data, so no discrimination issue arises in that context either.
- **GDPR Rights (EU/UK Users):** If you are in the European Union or United Kingdom, in addition to the above rights, you have rights under the GDPR and UK data protection law, including: the right to **object** to or **restrict** certain processing (though note, we process very minimally and only what's necessary for the service – if you object to, say, processing your ID, we'd likely have to deactivate your use of the service as we cannot run it without an identifier); the right to **data portability** (we can provide your data in a portable format upon request, though this is basically just the hashed ID and points history); and the right to **withdraw consent** if we relied on consent (for most of our processing, we rely on contractual necessity or legitimate interests, but where we do rely on consent, you can withdraw it at any time). You also have the right to lodge a complaint with a Data Protection Authority in your country if you believe we have violated your data rights.

To exercise any of your rights or make any requests regarding your personal data, **please contact us at** contact@hyperfox.world. We may need to verify your identity (for example, by confirming you control the Discord account in question) before fulfilling certain requests, to ensure we don't delete or disclose data to the wrong person. Verification might involve asking you to perform a certain action via the Hyper Fox

Discord bot or provide certain information that only you would know. We will respond to requests as soon as possible and within any timeframe required by law (e.g., within 30 days for many requests).

Age Restrictions

Our service is intended for users who are 18 years of age or older. Hyper Fox is a rewards and gaming service that is **strictly 18+**. We do not knowingly collect or solicit personal information from anyone under the age of 18 ⁵. The content and offers provided (such as surveys and games of skill/chance) are geared toward adults, and our Terms of Service also prohibit under-18 users.

If you are under 18, please do not use Hyper Fox or provide any information to us. If we learn that we have inadvertently collected data from a person under 18, we will delete that information promptly. Similarly, if a parent or guardian becomes aware that a minor under their care has used Hyper Fox and provided personal data, please contact us at contact@hyperfox.world so we can take appropriate action to remove the data and terminate the minor's account.

(Note: Our third-party offer providers may have their own age restrictions (often 18+ as well, given the nature of surveys/offers). We are not responsible for any misrepresentation of age a user might make to those services, but if we discover a user is underage, we will enforce our restriction.)

By using Hyper Fox, you affirm that you are at least 18 years old.

Data Security

We take the security of your data seriously and implement reasonable and appropriate measures to protect it. Given that we store very limited personal data, we focus on keeping those data elements pseudonymized and secure:

- **Hashing and Encryption:** As described, we store your Discord ID and IP in **hashed** form, which is a form of encryption that is one-way. This means even in the unlikely event of unauthorized access to our database, an attacker would only see hashed values, not your actual Discord ID or IP. We use industry-standard cryptographic hashing algorithms (with salting and peppering techniques) to ensure these hashes cannot feasibly be reversed or cracked. Additionally, any sensitive communications between the Discord bot, our website, and our database are transmitted over **encrypted connections (HTTPS)**.
- **Access Controls:** Our servers and databases are protected by firewalls and network security measures. Access to production data is restricted to authorized personnel only (in practice, only the Hyper Fox developer/administrator). We employ authentication, keys, and, where possible, encryption at rest to guard the data. Physical access to servers (if any) is controlled by our hosting provider's security measures. We limit any third-party access to the bare minimum required to operate the service.
- **Organizational Practices:** We maintain up-to-date security practices, including keeping software and dependencies updated to patch vulnerabilities, monitoring for suspicious activities, and

regularly reviewing our code and configurations for security improvements. We also plan for backups and disaster recovery, to protect data integrity in case of hardware failures.

Despite all these precautions, it's important to note that **no method of transmission or storage is 100% secure** on the internet ⁶. We strive to protect your information and have implemented strong safeguards, but we **cannot guarantee absolute security**. For example, there's always some risk that data could be accessed unlawfully through a breach or due to factors outside our control (such as zero-day exploits or if you have a compromised Discord account). **You use Hyper Fox at your own risk**, understanding that we are doing our best to keep your data safe. We will promptly inform users of any data breach that compromises personal data, and take necessary steps to mitigate any harm.

By keeping only hashed and minimal data, we aim to ensure that even in a worst-case scenario, your actual personal information remains protected (since we simply do not store it in plain form). We also invite users to notify us at `contact@hyperfox.world` if you have any security concerns or suspect any vulnerabilities in our system – responsible disclosure is welcomed.

International Data Transfers

Hyper Fox is operated from the **United States** (our servers are hosted in New York, USA). If you are accessing our service from outside the US, please be aware that your limited personal data (like the hashed ID and IP) will be transferred to and processed in the United States. This may involve storing data on servers located in the US. The U.S. may not have the same level of data protection laws as your home country (for example, European users' data will be in a country that, at present, is not covered by an EU adequacy decision).

However, we take steps to ensure that your privacy is respected according to this policy no matter where our servers are located. By using Hyper Fox, you **consent to the transfer of your information to the United States** and acknowledge that it will be subject to U.S. laws. We will handle your information in accordance with this Privacy Policy, and for EU/UK users, we rely on **legitimate interest** (providing you the service you requested) as the lawful basis for this transfer and processing. If necessary, we are willing to enter into Standard Contractual Clauses or similar agreements to satisfy international data transfer requirements, although given the extremely limited data we process, our exposure is minimal.

If you have any questions about international data handling or want more information on how we can accommodate local data protection requirements, please contact us. We continuously monitor legal developments (such as new EU-U.S. data transfer frameworks) to ensure compliance.

Changes to This Privacy Policy

We may update or modify this Privacy Policy from time to time to reflect changes in our practices, legal requirements, or for other operational reasons. If we make material changes (i.e., changes that significantly affect how your personal data is handled), we will notify users by posting the updated policy on our website **and** (for important changes) by an announcement via the Hyper Fox Discord bot or server. We will update the "Effective Date" at the top of this policy to indicate when the changes take effect.

It's a good idea to review this Privacy Policy periodically to stay informed about how we are protecting your information. **Your continued use of Hyper Fox after any changes to this policy constitutes your acceptance of the updated terms.** If you do not agree with any update, you should discontinue using the service and can request that your data be deleted.

We keep prior versions of this Privacy Policy archived, and you can request a copy if you're interested in seeing how it has evolved. (For minor changes that do not materially affect your rights, we may not send out a specific notice, but the changes will still be reflected in the posted policy online.)
